

# DRT RESCUE WORKSHOP

Thanks for asking about training with  
Tree Climbing Northwest!



This workshop deals with rescue in the context of technical DRT tree climbing. You will learn how to use special tools\* designed specifically for rescue. We will cover how to improvise with what you have on your saddle at the moment of need. We will examine multiple rescue scenarios, from a stubborn climber not wanting to come down to an unconscious climber stuck high aloft. We will address problem solving and challenge your creative thinking. As with all TCNW classes, you will get plenty of time on rope to practice every scenario.

The focus of this workshop will be single pitch DRT rescue. As a bonus, multi-pitch DRT and SRT rescues will be demonstrated. Training in the latter will be included in a future Advanced Rescue Workshop that will be open to graduates of this DRT Rescue Workshop.

This workshop is scheduled for 3 days. We will start promptly at 2 pm on the first day and end by 5 pm. The following two full days begin at 9:00 am and end around 5:00 pm. Please arrange travel times so that you can stay until the class ends.

This course is physically and mentally demanding. It requires considerable stamina. Your muscles may be sore and you will be tired at the end of each day. And you'll have a lot of fun learning, and with successful course completion, you'll receive a "DRT Rescue Workshop" certificate and be prepared to respond effectively when single-pitch DRT rescue is called for. Come well rested and be ready for a *treemendous* learning experience!

## ENROLLMENT

A minimum of 3 students is required for the course to go forward. Maximum enrollment is 6. Minimum age to participate in this workshop is 18 years.

## Prerequisites

Basic Tree Climbing Course or TCNW Basic Tree Week

Participants must provide their own personal DRT tree climbing gear (subject to instructor approval)

## REGISTRATION AND TUITION

Tuition for this course is \$450.00.

Registration with deposit is accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Advance registration is required, and must be accompanied by a non-refundable deposit of at least 50% of the tuition amount. **The balance payment is due two (2) weeks before the first day of the course.** Tuition refunds minus a \$50.00 processing fee will be allowed only in the event of an extreme family or health emergency. If the course is cancelled by Tree Climbing Northwest, we will reschedule registrants for a subsequent session of the course. The tuition fee does not include food, lodging, or transportation to the climbing site. Please bring your own lunch to both full days of the course.


## MANUAL ENROLLMENT
